序

この目録は、当館が文部省から配分された昭和62年度全国共同利用図書（大型コレクション）購入予算によって受入れた「グルジヤ、アルメニア、コーカサス歴史、文化、言語等研究資料」の目録である。

本コレクションは、コーカサス研究では世界の第一人者であるロンドン大学のラング教授（Prof. David Marshall Lang）が多年にわたって蒐集した蔵書の一部である。

その内容は、グルジヤを中心として、コーカサス及びアルメニアの文化、歴史に関する基本的な文献とグルジヤ語、ロシア語で書かれた美術、社会、人文科学など幅広い分野に関する多数のオリジナル文献からなっている。特に、現在単行本としても入手困難となっている文学関係のテキストやコーカサス関係主要雑誌の論文抜刷、パンフレット類が多数含まれており、異色のコレクションとして注目される。

コーカサス地域の研究に限らず、ソ連（ロシア）、西アジア、東方キリスト教社会など、様々な立場からの利用が期待される。

学内をはじめ、学外関係者各位に有効に利用されることを希望したい。
